## **INSTALLATION TECHNICIAN**

### **General Responsibilities**

- Perform installation of paint booths, air make up units, fans, exhaust systems, ductwork
- Mechanical and electrical installation of equipment
- Coordinate testing and start-up of equipment and perform safety check before leaving job site.
- Work closely with customers and sales department to insure proper installation and maintenance
- Maintain a high level of knowledge of all types of systems and be familiar with system upgrades offered
- Train and instruct customers on their new systems and services
- Exhibit professional appearance and conduct in accordance with established company standards to present a professional image to customer and the general public
- Maintain accurately all work records and parts used at each job in accordance with established procedure as well as track costs, hours and performance on projects.
- Sight inspection of jobsite before project is quoted to include layouts, instruction and proposed equipment location.
- Location of electrical air and gas hookup and positioning of equipment
- Evaluate current layout and estimate hours required to complete the project.
- Attainment of schedules and adherence to project budgets
- Maintain company vehicles, tools and other property in proper manner.

### **Employment Pre-Requisites**

- Vocational education is preferred, electrical education a plus
- Knowledge of machines and tools including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance
- Experience repairing and servicing industrial equipment
- Mechanically work well with your hands
- Must have some electrical or small engine repair experience
- Proficiency with common computer applications such as Microsoft Office
- Literate with AutoCad recommended
- Able to read a blueprint and electrical drawings required.
