

REPAIR TECHNICIAN

General Responsibilities

- Perform maintenance/repair on equipment such as spray guns, pumps, regulators, etc brought in by customers or sales reps
- Determine what kind of maintenance is needed based on operating failures/errors and decide what type of repair is needed
- Clean equipment before repairing using solvents.
- Disassemble equipment and determine the parts needed to complete the repair
- Research manufacturers' part sheets for correct parts to be ordered
- Order parts for repair
- Receiving of equipment parts
- Repair of equipment using company tools and supplies to complete repair
- Conduct final tests and inspections on the repaired equipment to evaluate quality, proper working order, efficiency and performance of the equipment
- Keep accurate records of equipment information: customer, contact, type of equipment received, date received, parts ordered, parts received
- Responsible for shop tools and equipment
- Assist as warehouse back-up of receiving parts/equipment by UPS and truck. Packaging orders and shipping duties

Employment Pre-Requisites

- Vocational education is preferred
- Knowledge of machines and tools
- Experience repairing and servicing industrial equipment.
- Mechanically work well with your hands.
- Must have some electrical or small engine repair experience.
- Proficiency with common computer applications such as Microsoft Office
